Using technology responsibly

Technology has a footprint and how it is run matters.

As a managed services provider, we make day to day decisions about how and where systems are configured, monitored and maintained. We apply the same principles to client environments that we apply to our own, by avoiding unnecessary waste, using capacity responsibly. We help organisations to recognise how they can reduce energy use and environmental impact, by simplifying IT estates, removing duplication and only running the capacity that is needed.

By managing and modernising critical digital infrastructure technologies that deliver greater efficiency with lower power consumption, we ensure we can architect and promote newer and greener technologies, which can scale to provide the capacity as and when it is needed.

This approach strengthens resilience, reliability, and long-term operability of critical IT systems.

When phones and laptops reach the end of their working life with us, we do not simply dispose of them. Where possible, we donate them through our colleague's charity, Seeds for Development. This extends the life of equipment, reduces electronic waste and supports access to technology in remote villages in northern Uganda.

Looking after people in our communities

Recarta has been working with local schools by helping run Breakfast Clubs and taking breakfast directly into schools. Access to a healthy breakfast supports children's wellbeing and their ability to concentrate and learn. By providing breakfast for all, we help remove a stigma for families who may struggle to afford it.

We donate Recarta's used and refurbished mobile phones and laptops to Seeds for Development, a local charity working with remote farming communities in northern Uganda. We are also looking to extend this to our clients – so they can recycle their unwanted end user devices to charity whilst performing the necessary data destruction etc.

Recarta is looking to build on this initiative and researching opportunities to deliver IT training and educational support to Ugandan communities.

We also donate tickets to sporting events and concerts so charities can auction them to raise funds. These contributions help local organisations such as the Bevern Trust continue their great work and strengthen community support networks.
